STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY REPORT 2021-22

The Institution has an enrolment of more than 12124 students in Under-Graduate, Post-Graduate and in professional Courses like Teachers' Training, BBA and Law.

The students are an integral part of the Institution. In order to capture the experiences of students for the academic session 2021-22, a questionnaire has been framed and forwarded online. The questionnaire of the survey includes 21 questions to which the students of the Institution with the help of Google Forms give responses anonymously. The survey components include an Institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experiences. Students' Satisfaction Survey was conducted during the months of July-August, 2021.

The outcome of the survey helps to reach the objective of the Institution. This also helps to initiate remedial action to improve the facilities whenever and wherever it is required. The result of the survey provides a base to formulate plan for the future.

Totally, 4684 students responded to Students' Satisfaction Survey. The analysis of the survey conducted shows that, 3550 students were highly satisfied with the Teaching-Learning Processes of the Institution. Students have expressed satisfaction over the syllabus offered/adopted under National Education Policy (NEP)-2020 and their coverage in the classes and laboratories.

The survey questionnaire include the parameters like facilities syllabus, redressal of grievances, course outcomes and related activities in the College and this revealed that the students are highly satisfied. At the same time, the students highly appreciated and were satisfied with the implementation of learning outcomes based curriculum which includes communication of teachers with students, teaching methodology, seminar works and its follow up made by the faculty throughout the session.

The highly satisfied students also acknowledge the efforts put by the faculty in promoting and conducting-hands on Training Sessions, Interdisciplinary Learning Programmes implemented in the Institution since they are very much helpful to them to see the world beyond their prescribed curriculum and motivating them to learn other subjects.

The parameters like faculty participation in identifying strength and weaknesses to strengthen and overcome those respectively, Institutional ability in inculcating "Soft Skills", "life skills" and "employment skills" among students to the world of words, teaching with ICT tools by the faculty along with the appropriate teaching pedagogy has been rated high in the survey.
