**Summary of webinar**

The keynote speakers of the session were Dr. Ankur Seth and Dr. Sudhakar Singh. First keynote speaker Dr. Ankur Seth is a well known Psychiatrist and has dealt with number of mental patients. He said that every age group is processing Covid -19 in a different way. Children and teenagers are facing hard time with lack of social circle. So it is important for parents to not brush aside their queries and engage them in different activities.

Second keynote speaker Dr. Sudhakar Singh is a very prominent figure of Sultanpur. He is not only a paeditioner but also a dedicated social worker. He is coordinator of Gayatri Pariwar and is Patron of various NGO's like Ankuran


Foundation, Unity Foundation, etc. He emphasized on taking proper care, engaging yourself in different activities and not to panic as death rate is only 2.5% in India which is even less than diarrhoea death in India.



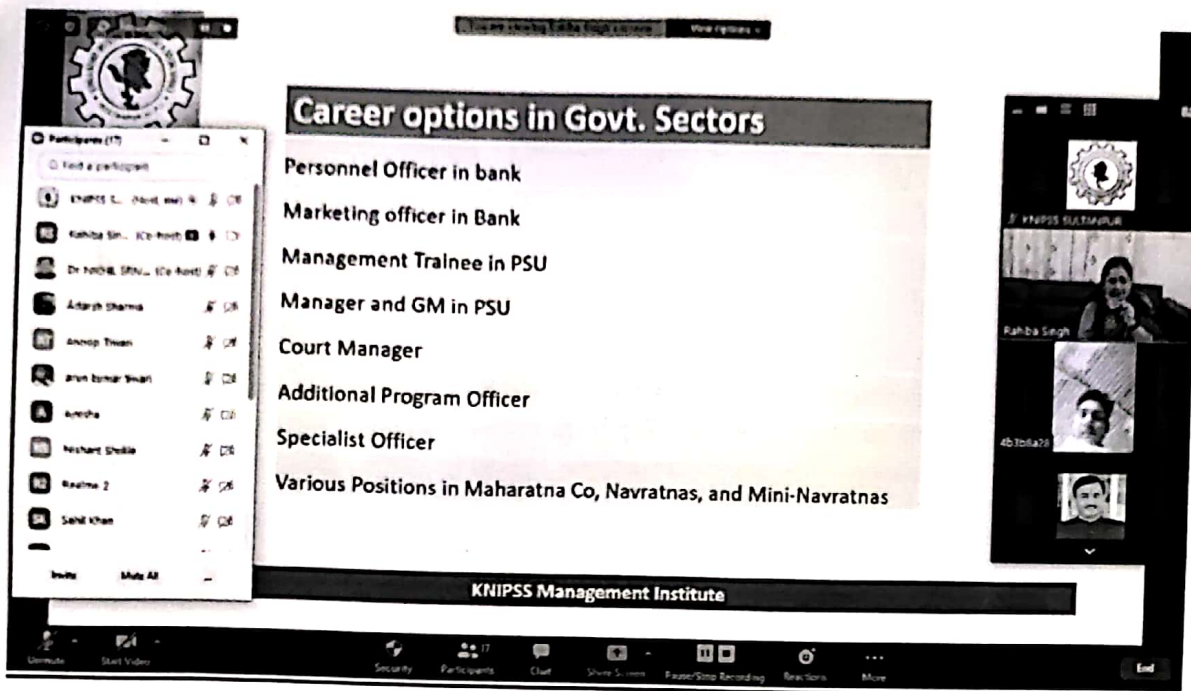
